RIDING EXPECTATIONS: Candidate should ride in an enclosed area without lead line, demonstrating control while maintaining a safe basic balanced position at the medium walk and working trot, and should begin to develop the canter. These expectations are applied to each block of the test.

•	Perform balancing and suppling exercises for rider at halt and walk and discuss 2 reasons for doing this.

•	Demonstrate free walk and medium walk on light contact.		DNMS	
•	Ride at the walk and working trot on correct diagonal, performing simple turns and 20-meter circles at the rising or sitting trot to show awareness of bend.			
•	Ride at the canter in both directions in an enclosed area and correcting any wrong leads.		ES DNMS	
•	Ride without stirrups at the walk.		MS	
•	Discuss performance to include if mount was looking in the directions of the turns (bend) and whether or not mount was on correct leads.		ES DNMS MS	
•	Discuss how to pass others safely while riding in an enclosed area.
